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NOTE: The guidelines for Senior Inquiry, created by EPC in 2006, was shared at this session in order to highlight the large degree of overlap between <u>the AAC&U's "Signature Work" construct</u> and Augustana's own vision of what Senior Inquiry should entail.

EPC Senior Inquiry Guidelines (2006)

The Educational Policies Committee (EPC) approved in its 2006 Senior Inquiry Guidelines that each department's SI would be:

- Substantial in meaning and impact
- Communicative of the discoveries made through the project
- Reflective of one or more of the following:
 - the nature of knowledge and inquiry
 - self-awareness and connection with others
 - the relationship of individuals to a community

In addition to these outcomes, departments are encouraged to design programs that enable students to integrate two or more of the general education dispositions.

All SI projects—including creative projects—should result in a permanent record.
