## Burials in the St. Ansgarius Church (Minneapolis) 1892–1900

The St. Ansgarius Swedish Episcopal Church in Minneapolis was located at the corner of 5th Avenue and 19th Street South from 1892 to 1936. The first service was held on Oct. 23, 1892 by the Rev. Olof A. Toffteen<sup>1</sup> in Tollefson's Hall and the mission was organized a couple of months later, on Dec. 26, 1892 by Bishop Mahlon Norris Gilbert, Assistant Bishop of Minnesota. In May of 1893 the membership had reached 100 and the mission was organized as the Parish of St. Ansgarius Swedish Episcopal Church of Minneapolis. Permission was given to use the rites of the Church of Sweden, so long as the parish continued to use the Swedish language. On Sept. 13, 1893 a church building was completed at the cost of \$7,000.00.

The membership of the Swedish parish was made up largely of the laboring class among the Swedish immigrants, who, according to Bishop H. B. Whipple, "had given gladly to sustain and support their pastor."<sup>2</sup>

The following abstract of burials from the St. Ansgarius Church constitutes a unique record for the study of genealogy and family history in Minnesota. These records mirror an effort by the Episcopal Diocese of Minnesota to work with one of the largest ethnic communities within the diocese. Because of the interest and activities of Bishop Gilbert, several other Swedish Episcopal churches were organized within the Diocese. In addition to St. Ansgarius Church, there was the Messiah Episcopal Church, founded in 1893, the same year that St. Johannes' Church was founded, both in Minneapolis. In St. Paul, the St. Sigfrid's Church was organized in 1898 and in Litchfield the Emmanuel Church was founded in 1891. The St. Sigfrid's Church in Cokato was founded in 1892 and about the same time small Swedish missions were organized in Eagle Bend, Aitken and Lake Park.

Only the church records of the three churches in the metropolitan area are known to be extant today. The records have been transferred to the Archives of

the Episcopal Diocese of Minnesota and are housed at Lane Hall in Minneapolis. The records have also been microfilmed by the Minnesota Historical Society. The church records of the Emmanuel Church in Litchfield are believed to be incorporated within the parish records of the Trinity Episcopal Church of Litchfield.

These records should contribute another genealogical segment to the everincreasing store of knowledge concerning our Swedish immigrant forefathers. We are indeed grateful to the Episcopal Diocese of Minnesota for making this material available to the general public.

A word about the records themselves. The burials from the St. Ansgarius Church are recorded in a volume labelled Vol. II. This book includes among other things all of the burials which took place in the church from the organizing of the mission up to the year 1900. As will be seen, the notations are quite sparse, giving the name of the deceased, the date of death, the date of burial and the age of the deceased, expressed in years, months and days. Occasionally, but very rarely, is the name of the cemetery mentioned. Lakewood Cemetery exists today and is located at 3600 Hennepin Avenue South. Layman Cemetery was a private cemetery named for a person named Layman. Though it is still located on Lake Street and Cedar Avenue in Minneapolis, it is no longer an active cemetery and is now cared for by the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board.

All names are listed as recorded in the material. Where there is a question concerning the spelling, the corrected name has been placed within brackets. Since there does not seem to be a membership book for the church, nothing further can be added to the names listed here.

Olof A. Toffteen was born in Hexarve, Sprog Parish (Got.), Sweden June 26, 1863. After studies at the University of Uppsala, he emigrated to the U.S. in 1888, where he joined the Episcopal Church in 1892. On Jan. 1, 1893 he was ordained a deacon. He was ordained pastor in the Minnesota Diocese June 21, 1893 and served the St. Ansgarius Church in Minneapolis until 1901. — Alfred Söderström, Minneapolis Minnen (Minneapolis, 1899), pp. 238-241.
