# A Swedish Passenger List from 1857

No one will deny that the passenger lists or manifests covering the arrivals of persons into the United States, ever since 1820, have been a veritable gold mine for thousands of persons seeking their roots abroad. Not only do these manifests prove the arrival of a certain individual at a certain time, but they may also be used to identify the passenger's origin, if, as in many cases, the manifest also lists the place abroad, where the passenger hailed from. Not all the lists are that helpful. For Swedish vessels we seldom get more information than that Sweden is the country of the person's nativity. When we do come across passenger lists which also include the place-names from which the passenger came, we are indeed quite fortunate. This is all the more valuable, considering the name system in vogue in Sweden during the 19th century, the custom in the rural areas of using the "-son" name or the patronymic. Confronted with almost solid lists of Johnsons, Petersons and Svensons, it is quite obvious that the additional information we get in the more detailed lists helps immeasurably in the identification process.

On 18 Sept. 1857 the ship *Carolina* with Capt. Joel Westerberg at the helm, arrived in New York from the port of Gävle on the Baltic coast in north central Sweden. Of the 143 passengers aboard, only one died at sea, the eight month-old son of Pehr Olof Pehrsson (No. 70). Of the remaining 142 who went ashore in New York, only three stayed in that city—Hans Mauritz Alexandersson and his wife Anna Ulrika Forssell, and Gustaf Fabian Gafvelholm (No. 13-15). All of the remaining passengers were destined for Illinois. All of the passengers were quartered in the steerage space between decks. Only four persons enjoyed the comfort and luxury of a cabin—Michael Michaelsson (No. 4), who had been in the U.S. earlier, and Hans Mauritz Alexandersson and his wife (No. 13-14) and Sergeant Gafvelholm (No. 15).

It has been possible to identify almost all of those passengers who came from the parishes of Gnarp, Ovensjö, Bergsjö, Åmot and Hassela. Unfortunately the parish records of Ockelbo in Gävleborg County (*län*) were destroyed by fire in 1904; the records of Älvros Parish in Jämtland *län* were likewise destroyed in a blaze in 1870. Thus we do not have access to the pertinent information concerning about half of the *Carolina* passengers who came from Ockelbo and Älvros.

Most of the identifications have been located in the parish records on deposit in the District Archives of Härnösand (*Landsarkivet i Härnösand*), abbreviated in the notes as *HLA*.

The passenger manifest is presented as is, as prepared by Capt. Westerberg for the port authorities in New York. In some cases the place-name has been normalized and this is placed in brackets. For identification of the microfilm used for this study, it is item No. 1128 on microfilm roll No. 179 in the National Archives Microfilm Series M 237. The names have been numbered by the authors to facilitate easy reference.

<sup>1</sup>Nils Ingemarsson was b. in Attmar Parish (Vn.) 14 Jan. 1813, s. of Ingemar Johansson, farmer in Söderböle in Attmar, and his wife Stina Nilsson. He was m. to Ingrid Magdalena Mattsdotter, b. in Attmar 3 Sept. 1823, dau. Matts Johansson, crofter (*torpare*) in Backa, Attmar, and his wife Ingrid Jönsdotter. Their s. Ingmar was b. in Njurunda Parish (Vn.) 10 June 1849. The family left for America from Attmar 1857. —*HLA*.

<sup>2</sup>Michael Michaelsson was b. in Attmar Parish 17 Dec. 1824, s. of Michael Mårtensson, farmer and church warden (*kyrkvärd*) in Karläng in Attmar, and his wife Sigrid Ingemarsdotter. In the household examination rolls for Attmar he is listed as having returned from America 1856 and departed again for America 1857. He is probably identical with a passenger, M. Michaelsson, who emigr. 1850 and arr. in New York 1 Nov. 1850 aboard the *Oden* together with several other passengers from Attmar. —*HLA*; Nils William Olsson, *Swedish Passenger Arrivals in New York 1820-1850* (Stockholm and Chicago 1967), p. 256.
