Västergötland Immigrants in New Britain, CT

The parish records of the Swedish immigrant churches in the United States provide us with some excellent source materials for tracing our roots back to Sweden. The Augustana Lutheran Church, now a part of the Lutheran Church in America, grew and developed under the guidance of clergymen trained in the State Lutheran Church in Sweden. Since the Swedish Church had a long tradition of keeping careful vital statistical records for every parish in Sweden, it was only natural that the progeny in America would carry on the traditions of the mother church in Sweden. Good record keeping was one of the more important benefits brought to the immigrant church in the United States.

Since my own grandfather, Adolph Johnson (Adolf Johansson in Sweden) joined the First Lutheran Church of the Reformation in New Britain, CT in 1912 and since he was born in the parish of Kalv in the province of Västergötland, I thought that it would be an interesting study to go through the New Britain church records to see how many of its members came from Kalv and the neighboring parish of Östra Frölunda and joined the New Britain church during the period 1885-1895. While it was fairly easy to check the parish rolls for members from these two parishes and their birth data, it took much more effort to validate this information by consulting the microfilms of the original Swedish parish records in the Genealogical Society Library in Salt Lake City, UT. In the majority of the cases the birth data checked out very well. There were a few minor differences in the birth date itself as between Kalv and Östra Frölunda on the one hand and the New Britain church on the other. These divergencies have been noted. In a few instances there was no record in the Swedish parish rosters of New Britain parishioners having been born there. This has also been noted below.

As I broke out the communicants in the New Britain church records, I was astounded by the number of members who enrolled in the church from two comparatively small parishes in in Västergötland during the ten-year period in question. Almost two score New Britain residents came from Kalv and a total of thirteen had their origin in Östra Frölunda. A substantial number also had their roots in such adjoining parishes as Håcksvik, Mårdaklev and Sjötofta in Älvsborg *län* and the parish of Gunnarp in the neighboring *län* of Halland.
