- A. Grandfather Charles Oscar Peterson, b. in Stockhlm 20 April 1856; d. in Somerville, MA 1937. Emigr. to the U.S. 1882. A machinist, he belonged to the Swedish Mechanics. He m. 1887-1888.
- B. Grandmother Carolina Wilhelmina Wigren, b. in Västergötland 26 Oct. 1866; d. Weymouth, MA 1941. Emigr. to the U.S. from Stockholm 1887. Member of the Swedish-American Society of Boston. Last known address in Sweden was c/o Pastor Johan August Söderlund, Ljungstedtska skolan in Linköping. Her mother's maiden name was Wahlström.
- C. Other Göran Wahlström, Swedish naval officer attached to Swedish Embassy in Washington, DC 1920. His dau. Märta m. in Washington. His youngest dau. m. a Swedish Navy lieutenant 1948. The father d. in 1948 when the mother and dau. moved to Folkungagatan 136-138 in Stockholm.

#### Andersson

My maternal uncle, Axel Bernhard Andersson, b. in Stora Beddinge, Tullstorp Parish (Malm.) 22 April 1898, emigr. to the U.S. via Kristiania (Oslo), Norway 20 July 1917 via *SS Bergensfjord*. He settled in Miami, FL, where he founded and operated a well-drilling company, A. B. Andersson Enterprises, Inc., located at 1550 N.W. 126th Street, Miami, FL 33167.

He m. a woman of English extraction with whom he had a son Alvin, also called "Bud". When his wife died, Andersson sent his son over to England to his wife's relatives, but Alvin subsequently returned to the U.S. Axel Bernhard Andersson became mentally ill, was placed in a mental hospital, where he died.

When the estate inventory was conducted after my grandmother's death in 1957, the document states that while Axel Bernhard was deceased, his son Alvin was alive, but his addres unknown.
