## Andersson, Hultberg

I am seeking parish of birth and possible descendants of Anders Andersson, b. in 1825 and his wife, Anna Maria, b. in 1865 (?), both in the province of Bohuslän in Sweden. Anders, along with his s. Oscar, b. 16 June 1861 and dau. Emelie Augusta, b. in 1857 with her husband, John Bond, b. in 1850 and his father, Andrew Bond, b. in 1822 emigr. in 1881, settling in Cloquet, MN. Some other children of Anders may have emigr. to Alaska or Australia in the 1880s and 1890s. One of these children was named Hans. I am hoping to find out the port from which they sailed, the name of the vessel and the port of entry in the U.S. Anders changed his name to Hultberg upon arr. in this country.

## Nyqvist, Johansson

Karl Johan Nyqvist was b. in Tingstäde or Hangvar Parish (Gotl.) 29 June 1865 and left Stenkumla Parish (Gotl.) for the U.S. 8 Nov. 1887. He is listed as a sailor in the Visby register of sailors.

Sofia Karolina Johansson, née Nyqvist was b. in Stenkumla or Hangvar Parish (Gotl.) 15 Jan. 1871. She had three children in Sweden and became a widow 8 Oct. 1892. She left her three children and departed for the U.S. 19 Oct. 1900.

Neither was ever heard from again. There was also a brother, August Fredrik Nyqvist, b. in Hangvar 13 Feb. 1869, who left Gotland and supposedly d. in April 1890 on board the *Meteor* somewhere between England and the U.S. Apparently there was a total of 14 siblings. None of the three above has been found on any Swedish embarkation list.

## Froid, Fröjd

I am seeking passenger lists for my ancestors who emigr. from Sweden in the 1860s.

Anders Fredrik Fröjd (Froid) arr. in the U.S. from Kisa Parish (Ög.) 18 Nov. 1867 at the age of 20. Family tradition also tells of the arrival in the U.S. 5 Oct. 1868 of Oscar Fröjd with his sister-in-law, Mathilda, and her infant dau. Anna Carolina. Research has shown that the widowed mother, Ingrid Catharina (Carrie) Fröjd, had m. Olaus Petersson while in Sweden and that they and other children also made the trip to America. Olaus seems to have taken the surname Froid, using the initial "P".

I am also searching for one of Carrie's dau., Inga Christina, wondering if she also made the journey.

## Benson, Bengtsson

I should like to know the name of Hedman's wife. The name in the census is blurred but may have been Hannah, b. in Sweden in 1850. Was the husband's name Charles and where is the origin in Sweden?

- 4. Carl Albin's niece, Elin Amanda Victoria Johansdotter Rahm, my grandmother's sister, was b. in Ruskelsby 21 July 1866 and emigr. 1888. In the U.S. she m. G. Adel Gustavsson, who had arr. in 1887. This couple res. in Hastings, MN until 1902 when they moved to Minneapolis, where Gustavsson was employed by the Washburn Crosby Co. They had three children Helen, Eskil and Ingrid. The last address we have of them was in 1938, when they res. on 34th Avenue South. Elin suffered from diabetes and was confined to a wheelchair. She never visited Sweden but wrote many letters which now have become lost.
